Could you play a key role in helping to keep your community safe and reduce casualties on the roads of Sussex?

We are currently looking for volunteers to join our Community SpeedWatch initiative.





Community SpeedWatch is a national initiative whereby members of the community assist their local police force in monitoring the speeds of vehicles.

Those caught exceeding the speed limit are referred to police, with the aim of educating drivers to reduce their speed. In cases where there is evidence of repeat or excessive offending, enforcement action – including prosecution, can be taken.

By joining the scheme as a volunteer, you will be helping Sussex Police to:

- Reduce speeding offences
- Reduce casualties from speed-related incidents
- Increase public awareness of safer driving
- Make your community a safer place
- Tackle antisocial driving and riding

Full training for the role will be provided by Sussex Police and volunteers are supported by their local Neighbourhood Policing Team.
